Childcare Contribution Tax Credit

What is the Childcare Contribution Tax Credit?

Both individuals and businesses that donate to programs that promote childcare in Colorado are able to claim a 50% tax credit on their state income taxes in addition to the regular state and federal deductions for a charitable contribution. Non-monetary contributions do not qualify.

How do I claim the tax credit?

The CCTC Certification (DR 1317) will be provided by the organization that you donated to, certifying your contribution.



Who can I donate to?

To claim a tax credit you can donate money for the establishment or operation of a child care facility or program in Colorado.

Some examples include:

- a licensed child care provider
- a licensed family child care home
- a licensed residential child care facility
- a registered child care program that provides services similar to a licensed child care center
- donating money for a registered grant or loan program for parents in Colorado requiring financial assistance for child care
- donating money for a registered training program for child care providers in Colorado
- donating money to a registered information dissemination program that assists parents with child care information and referral services, like
